
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Mom's Earrings list of materials

| | Name of the materials | |
|---|------------------------|--------------------|
| 1 | Seed beads size 11, A | 1g (0.5 really) |
| 2 | Seed beads size 11, B | 1g (0.7g really) |
| 3 | Aiko beads size 11, C | 1.5g (1.1g really) |
| 4 | Seed beads size 15, D | 1.2g (0.9g really) |
| 5 | 4 mm pearls | 6 |
| 6 | 6mm pearls | 4 |
| 7 | Flower cup bead, 7x5mm | 2 |
| 8 | Jump ring, 3-6mm | 2 |
| 9 | Ear wire | 2 |

Needed but not included in kit.

- 1. Beading needle #11 or 12
- 2. FireLine 4 or 6 lbs
- 3. E6000 glue
- 4. Scissors



1. For the first petal cut off about 35" of FireLine, thread the needle and pick up 3A, 2B, 4C, and 5D. Leave about 10" tail and work in peyote following *Diagram*1. When you finish the first half of the petal make the second half of the petal using the same needle and thread. Pay attention to Step 3 on Diagram 1.


2. Using the same thread and following Diagram 1 make the second petal. When you pick up 3A, 2B, 4C, and 5D line of the beads and start working in peyote technique make sure that you will have a small piece of thread showing between petals (about 1/8"). Photo 1.



3. Connect two petals together as shown in Photos 2-6.













- 4. Make the third petal the same way as the previous two and form a 3-petals flower.
- 5. Repeat previous steps again but make 4 petals this time and shape them as a 4-petals flower. Photo 7.



 You will have two finished flowers and each flower will have two thread ends.
Photo 8. Do not cut off the threads!!!!!




Pick the longest thread of the 3-petals flower and thread the needle with it. Pass your needle

and thread through the middle of the small flower and pick up one 6mm pearl, two 4mm pearls, one C and three D, pass back through C, pearls, and middle of the flower, pick up one more 6mm pearl and pass through the middle of the big flower. Photo 9.



7. Thread your needle with the second thread end from the small flower and pass through the 6mm pear and the middle of the big flower. Tight all 4 thread ends together and add small drop of the E6000 glue on the knot. Photo 10.



8. Pick the longest thread end and cut off the remaining three thread ends close to the drop of glue. Thread your needle with the saved thread ends and pick up one Flower bead, 4mm pearl, closed jump ring and pass down and then up again through the whole line of beads, pearls, and beaded flowers. Photo 11.



- 9. Attach whole piece to the ear wire.
- 10. Repeat Steps 1-9 to make a second earring!
- 11. Enjoy!
